ROC Tele-Mentors is Free and offers fast time support

Having a mentor is free and can offer close support to you for a period of 10 weeks, all we ask is that you actively engage with them.

Your Mentor is a friend with purpose who will offer a listening ear and help towards achieving a simple goal. All of our mentors are volunteers who are fully trained and checked.

Suitability Criteria

If you are a family with at least one child 12 years of age or under, you may be suitable for the programme.
